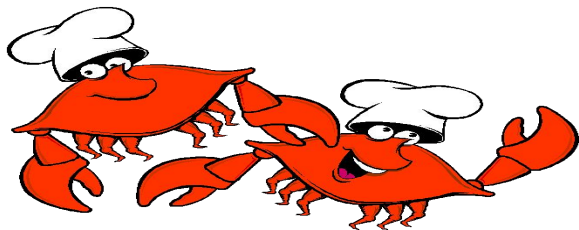

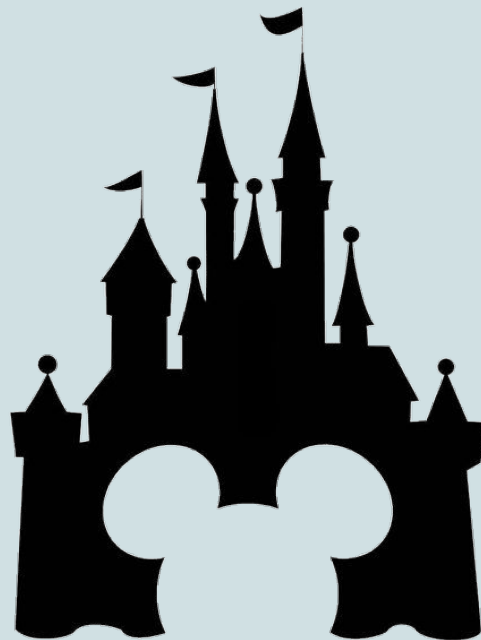

Once you have added a dependent, you must create a one-time order before your student is tested; you will not need to place another one after the initial order.

Additional Tips for Testing:

- Make sure you create an Order (must be done within 24hrs before testing)
- Have your Order number ready (taking a screenshot helps)
- Be patient with the new testing process
- This saliva test will require you to generate saliva without water in testing tube
