Students who are placed in quarantine for COVID exposure, having COVID symptoms, or testing positive for COVID will receive work to be completed independently during their quarantine in order to get credit for school attendance.

District, Student, and Parent/Guardian agree to the following:

- The major objective for the duration of the Master Agreement is to provide the student with a course of instruction that is based on the adopted district curriculum, and is substantially equivalent in quantity to classroom instruction.
- Specific resources posted through Google Classroom or Canvas, or other regularly assigned course work, digital assignments and materials available to the student are as follows: Grade level texts, practice sheets, and digital assignments posted through Google Classroom or Canvas. All work must be completed and returned to the teacher within one week from the conclusion of the Independent Study. A designee may allow for a student to submit completed work as and when it is due as needed. An evaluation of the student's work will be completed by the independent study instructor whenever the student must return between the dates an assignment is made and when it is due.
- The method utilized to evaluate student's work is subject to the discretion of the supervisory instructor.
- Upon successful completion of Independent Study, students will earn academic credit equivalent to the course of study. Incomplete contracts will result in unexcused absences.
- District shall provide the staff, instructional materials, and other necessary items for each assignment. Academic and other supports will be provided to address student needs.
- Independent Study is an optional educational alternative. No student may be required to participate in Independent Study.
- Student's participation in Independent Study is voluntary and is in the best interest of the student and determined by the student's parent/guardian and the District.
- The independent study option is to be substantially equivalent in quality to classroom instruction.

- El distrito proporcionará el personal, los materiales de instrucción y otros elementos y recursos necesarios según se especifique para cada asignación académica y de otro tipo apoyos. 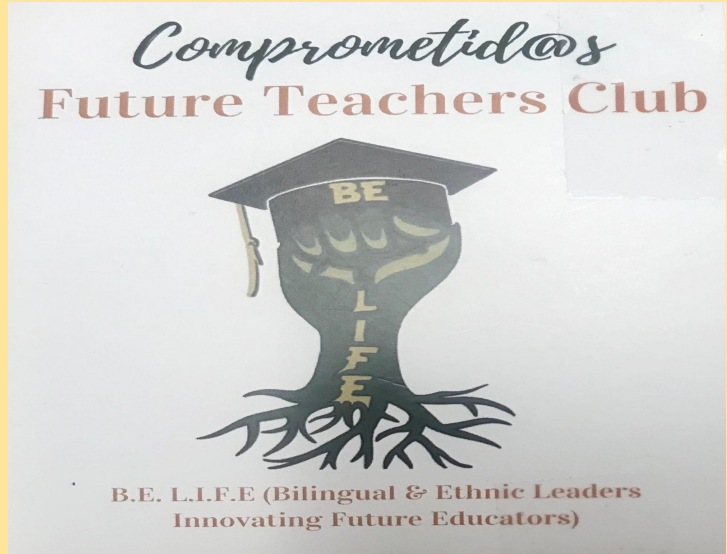

What is the State Seal of Biliteracy?

The State Seal of Biliteracy is a recognition by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction for graduating high school students who have attained a high level of proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing in one or more languages in addition to English. The State Seal of Biliteracy is marked by a gold seal affixed to the diploma or transcript.

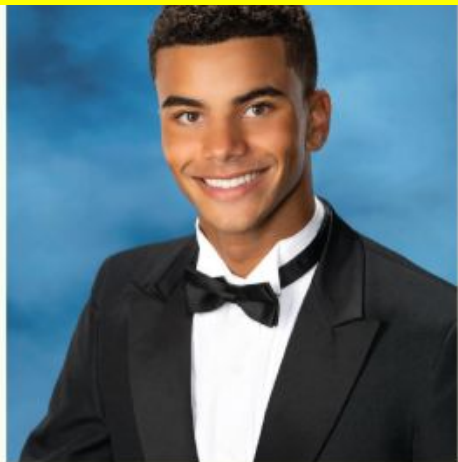
