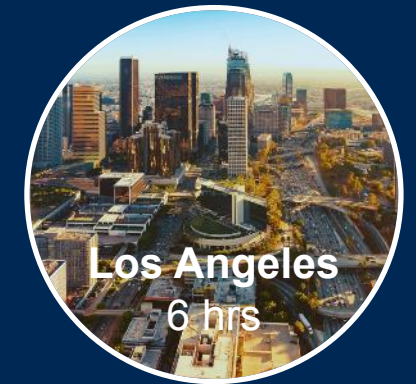

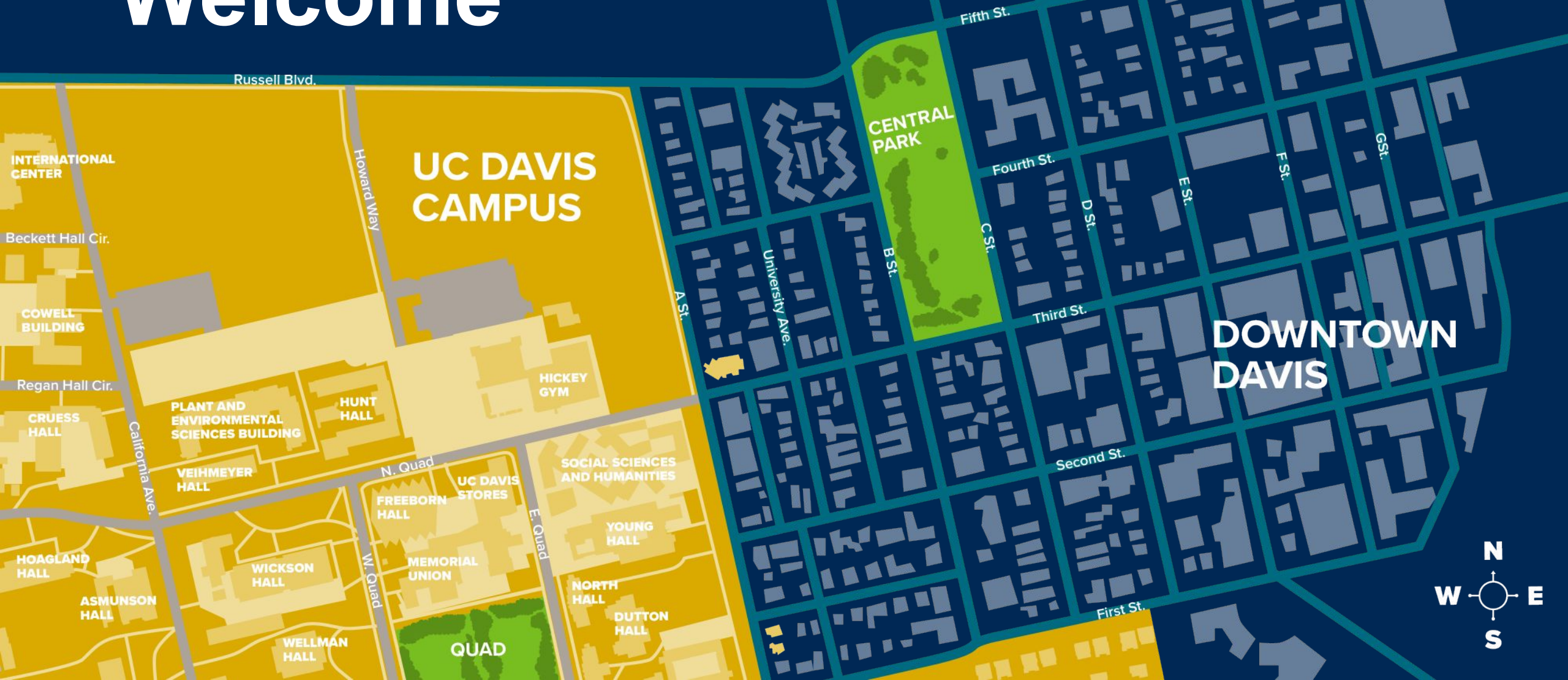

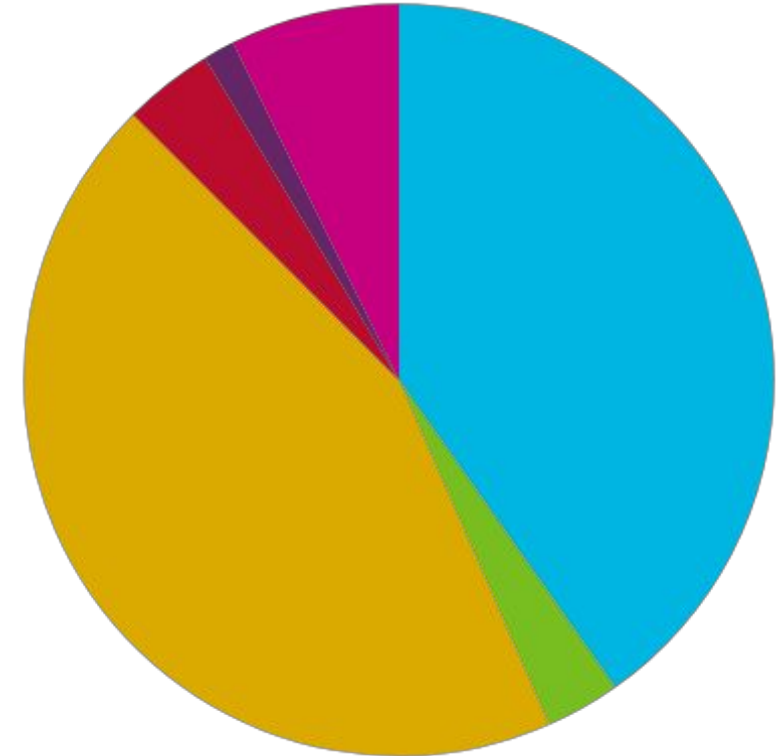
1. Grade point average (GPA)

10. Improvements in academic performance
11. Special talents, achievements and awards
12. Participation in educational preparation/academic enrichment programs
13. Academic accomplishment within life experiences
14. Geographic location

Complete the following “a–g” subjects with a C grade or better:

a. History/social science	Two years
b. English (or language of instruction)	Four years
c. Mathematics	Three years*
d. Laboratory science	Two years*
e. Language other than English (or second language)	Two years*
f. Visual and performing arts	One year
g. College preparatory elective	One year

*UC recommends one additional year of study

Earn a GPA of 3.00 or higher (GPA of 3.40 or higher for nonresidents)

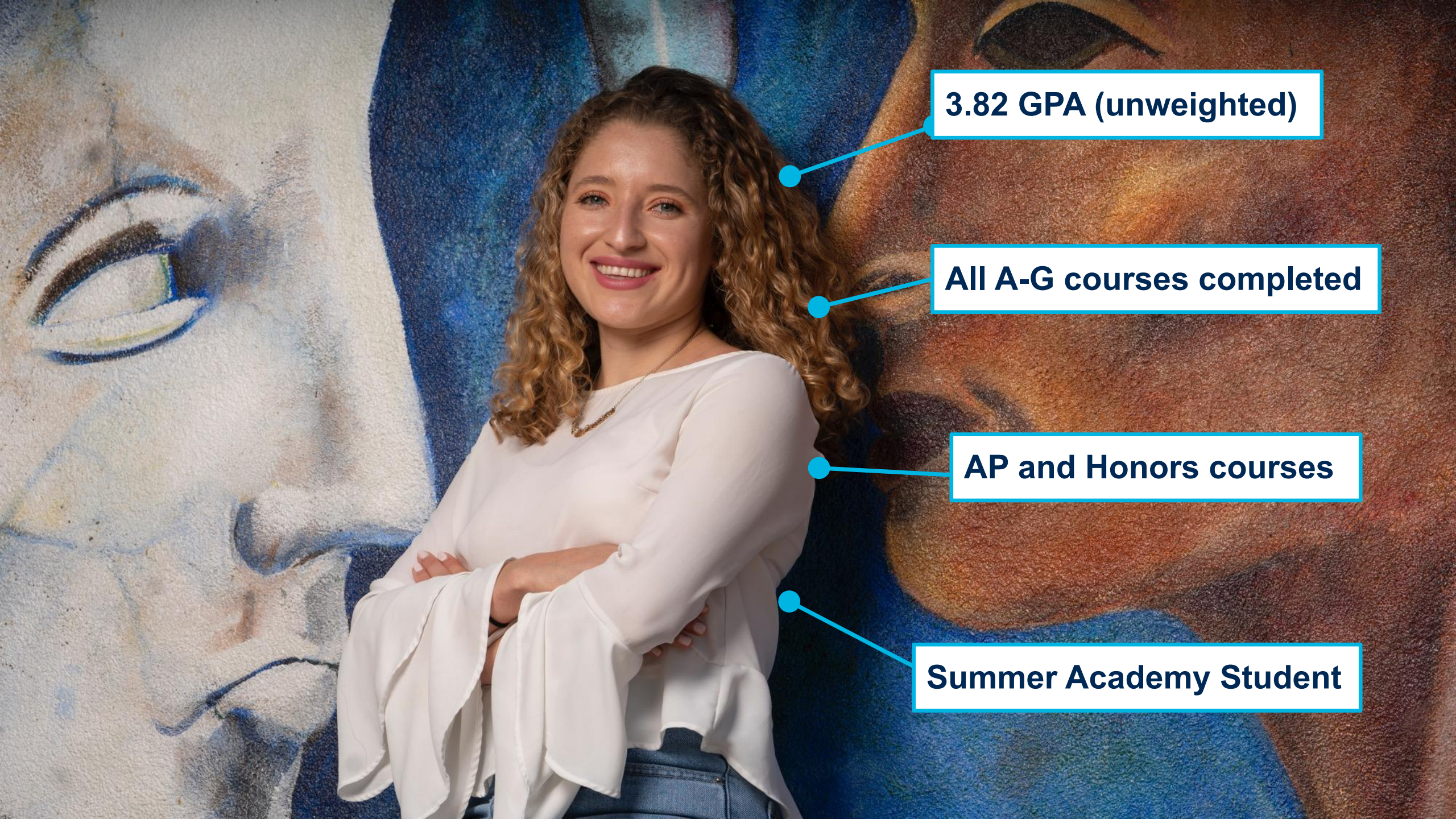

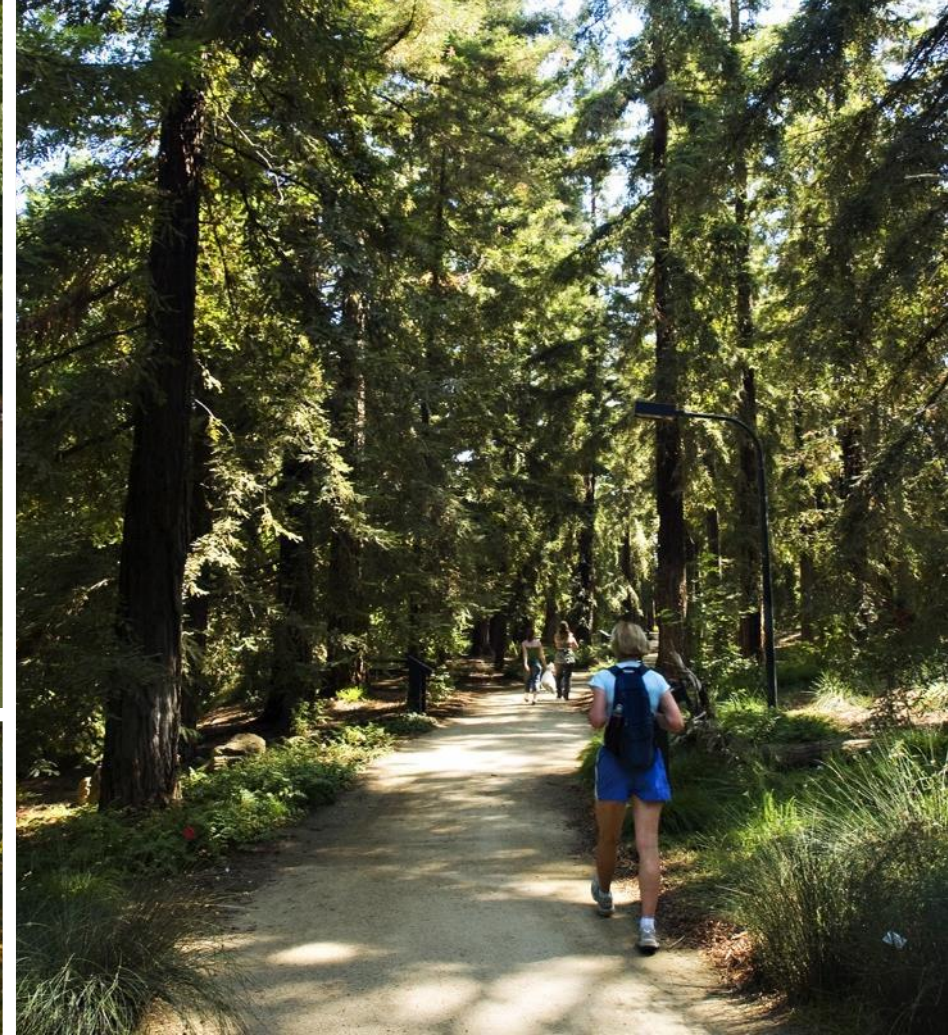
