# What are the responsibilities of the ELAC?


- The ELAC has four main responsibilities as outlined by the California State Department of Education.
- The ELAC will conduct a school needs assessment for English language learner.
- The ELAC will advise in the development and implementation of the school plan for English language learners submitted to the local board of education.
- The ELAC will review the school's language census(R30) in developing the school's plan for English language learners.
- The ELAC will help make parents aware of the importance of regular school attendance.
