

Graduation 1-Pager

Your one-stop-shop for information on the RCHS 2022 Graduation

Where and When:

Sutter Health Park (Rivercats Stadium)

June 3rd, 2022

Ceremony starts at 10am

Seniors and staff readers arrive at 9am

Student volunteers should arrive at 8:30AM

When you arrive:

Enter through the field gates (right hand side of the stadium if you are facing the main entrance) then head back to the area behind the field to find your location.

Cap decoration:

Seniors are allowed to decorate their caps (**if** you have purchased your own cap). Before the ceremony your staff reader will review all cap decorations; any inappropriate decoration will result in a confiscation of the cap and you will be given a blank cap. At this point, we trust Seniors to know what is and is not appropriate; you can always check with an Administrator if you have any questions.

Expectations:

We expect Seniors to continue to RISE during the pre-ceremony line up/waiting and the ceremony itself. While this ceremony is a celebration of you, it's not *just* about you. It's about your peers, your families, and your community coming together to recognize the achievement of the **entire** Senior Class. Please do not disrupt this event with inappropriate behavior; if you are not adhering to behavior expectations, you will be asked to leave. No drugs, alcohol, or tobacco will be allowed. Do not arrive under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Do not bring in noisemakers, beach balls, or other toys (remember, we have a contract with Sutter Health Park, if the Seniors are disrespectful to the Park and its rules, we will not be invited back for subsequent school years. Do not be the person who gets us uninvited for the next graduating class!)

What to wear:

School dress code applies. This is a semi-formal event, so we recommend slacks/dress pants, collared shirts/polos, dresses that fall to mid-thigh or lower. We do not recommend that students wear high heels; you will be walking on the warning track of the baseball field. The last thing you want is to lose your footing and fall face first onto the field; that's not the kind of "going viral" that you would hope for. **Robes will need to be zipped up for the ceremony; remember, this is a semi-formal event.** You may unzip for any personal pictures.

Clear Bag Policy:
