PROGRAM OVERVIEWS

RSP

This is our Resource Program. Students in this program are on track to receive their High School Diploma. Students typically take an Academic Success class both terms as their Special Education support class where they receive support that includes, but is not limited to, organization, college and career awareness, homework help, and academic skills support.

SDC Mod/Severe

Students in the SDC (Special Day Class) Mod/Severe program are in a Special Education classroom with ParaEducator support for the majority of the school day. These students take a General Education Elective with ParaEducator support each semester. Students in this program earn a Certificate of Completion.

SDC Mild/Mod

Students who are in our SDC (Special Day Class) program have the option of SDC Diploma track or SDC Certificate track. All SDC Mild/Mod student will take some General Education classes but will also be enrolled in Special Day Classes for the subjects in their greatest area of need.

For example, a student who is in SDC Diploma track may take Math 1 AND SDC Math to provide additional math support.

Students in SDC Certificate track will take mostly Special Day classes with Paraeducator support but will have General Education electives without Paraeducator support.
