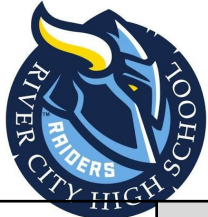



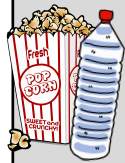

Students on the list will have one or more of the following:


- 2 or more Fs

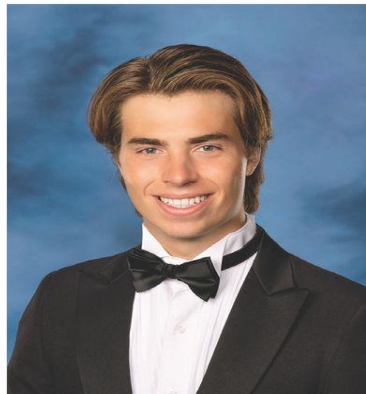

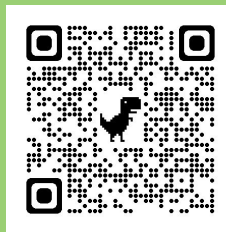

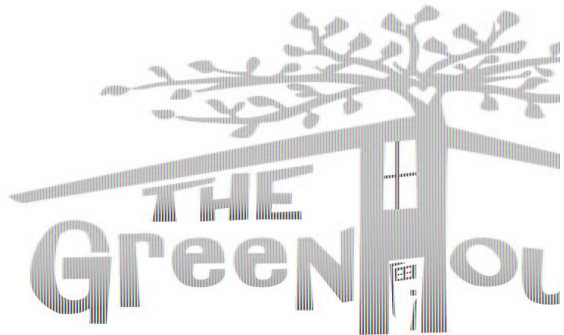
