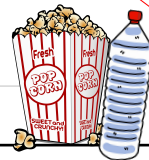
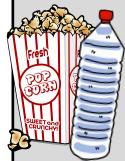



- Any suspension


