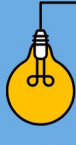

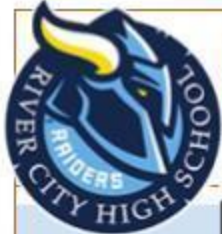

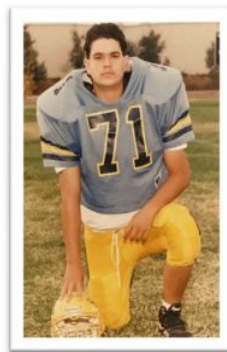
Student Eligibility
