Scholarship Overview

On average, Black women in STEM earn salaries that are 45% lower than their highest-paid peers. 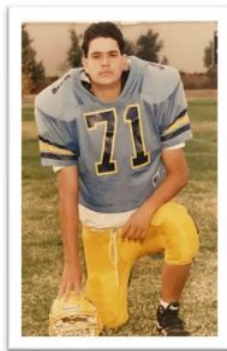
