Starting Thursday, we will be doing walk-up sales of the Yearbook! (\$103) We have about 75 books in stock!

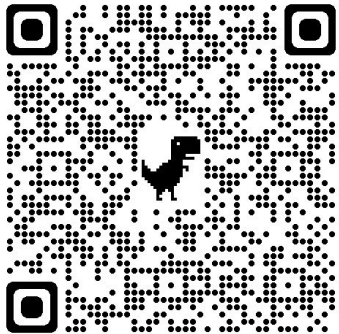

Scholarship Overview

On average, Black women in STEM earn salaries that are 45% lower than their highest-paid peers. 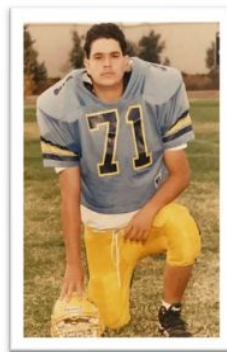
